Dear Marshall Families:

USDA has extended waivers for free qualified breakfasts & qualified lunches for the entire 2020-21 school year. Ala carte charges for milk, snacks or incomplete meals will still be charged to the student's account. We encourage families in need to continue to utilize the free and reduced meal application found at lunchapp.com. Paper versions will also be available from the secretary at your student's school. We ask at all grade levels that care be taken not to leave meals sent home on the buses.

Elementaries

At the end of Tuesday, each classroom will make available for each student a bag with one breakfast and one lunch.

Crowell ECSE

For Tuesday morning sessions a bag with an additional breakfast will be provided. For Tuesday afternoon sessions a bag with an additional lunch will be provided.

Middle School & High School Students Attending Monday & Tuesday

When school dismisses on Tuesday, a bag with three breakfasts and three lunches will be made available through the serving line in the cafeteria for fifteen minutes after school lets out.

Middle School & High School Students Attending Thursday & Friday

When school dismisses on Friday, a bag with three breakfasts and three lunches will be made available through the serving line in the cafeteria for fifteen minutes after school lets out.

Opportunity

At the end of Tuesday, a bag with one breakfast and one lunch will be made available on the south side of the library for ten minutes after school dismisses.
